Scholarship Award Procedure

This scholarship award will be announced in an official letter from the scholarship trustees. The official letter will serve as the winning applicant's document to present to the college of his or her choice. Upon verification from the college that the applicant has officially enrolled, the trustees will transmit a check to the college. The same procedure will be followed for grant renewal, but the student must provide the trustees with a transcript of the previous year's grades.

Withdrawal from College

Unexpended credit from the scholarship grant will be returned to American Legion Post 68 if the applicant withdraws from college. This also applies to a situation in which the college expels a student for any reason.
