L.J. Hollonbeck Memorial Track Award Guidelines

Description

The L.J. Hollonbeck Memorial Track Award will be given annually in memory of L.J. "Lefty" Hollonbeck, an SHS graduate of the class of 1939, who was an outstanding athlete in both basketball and track. He held a school record in the 880 yd. dash for 58 years. He was a National Honor Society member and received the good citizenship award at SHS.

During his lifetime he maintained a lively interest in the track athletes encouraging them to give their best to the sport, to display not only outstanding athletic ability but also dedication, courage, and good sportsmanship in all areas of their lives.

.This award is established to continue the encouragement of these principles in the track ethletes.

Award Presentation

The L.J. Hollonbeck Memorial Track Award will be given annually at Awards Night to a graduating student of SHS who has displayed outstanding athletic ability in track and field. The selected student should possess the qualities of dedication, courage, and good sportsmanship. Plans to further his/her education and/or demonstration of a lifelong interest in learning are required for presentation of the award.

L.J. Hollonbeck Memorial Track Award Guidelines

Eligibility

- Student may be male or female
- Student must have exhibited good character, citizenship, and good sportsmanship
- Student must be enrolled in a two-year junior college, or four-year college within one year of graduation from SHS
- After student is selected for nomination, the student is encouraged to complete nominee form

Criteria

- A student must compete for Sullivan High School in track and field to be eligible for consideration
- Preference will be given to students who have been chosen to be an athletic team captain by their teammates
- Preference will be given to students who exhibit courage and dedication as evidenced by a recommendation from their track coaches

Selection

- If no student is determined to be acceptable of the scholarship based upon the above criteria, the award may not be given for that particular year
- The HS boy's track coach and the HS girl's track coach, HS principal, HS athletic director, and HS guidance counselor will comprise the selection committee
- The criteria for awarding this scholarship should be reviewed on a yearly basis
