Guidelines for M.C.R.T.'S Scholarship

1. One \$500 scholarship will be given to a Moultrie County senior who is pursuing a career in education and has been selected by the scholarship committee.

2. The local scholarship committee will contact the Principal/Guidance Counselor to make sure that the application form is available.

3. The deadline for application will be April 12, 2012

4. The Principal/Counselor will see that the student application is **anonymously** submitted and will be notified of the winner.

5. A member of the scholarship committee will plan to attend the school's awards ceremony to award the scholarship.

6. The check will be issued in the fall (or summer if the recipient is enrolled in summer classes) when the student has officially enrolled. A second and 3^{rd} place winner will be kept on file in case of the disqualification of the recipient.

7. The recipient will receive his/her check once he/she has provided proof of enrollment in an accredited school to the MCRTA treasurer.
