

MARTHA AND JOSEPH SCHRODT FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Criteria

- Preference will be given to a student who demonstrates the most financial need as recommended by the high school administration
- Preference will be given to the student with need who has demonstrated the highest academic achievement as recommended by the guidance counselor and the assistant principal
- All ties will be broken by the building principal

Eligibility

- Student must be a current-year graduate of Sullivan High School
- Student must have exhibited high academic scholarship as verified by the counselor or assistant principal
- Student must be enrolled in a two-year junior college, four-year college, or vocational/technical school the semester following graduation

Selection

- If no student is determined to be acceptable of the scholarship based upon the above criteria, the award may not be given
- The High School Principal, Assistant Principal, and the Guidance Counselor will comprise the selection committee.
- The criteria for awarding this scholarship should be reviewed on a yearly basis.
